

Government Funded Hours Fact Sheet

There are 3 types of government funded hours

15 hours for eligible 2 year olds

15 hours for all 3 and 4 year olds

30 hours for eligible 3 and 4 year olds

To find out if you are eligible you need to apply via either of these websites

You <u>do not</u> need to apply for the 15 hours for 3 and 4 year olds

All funded hours start the term after a child's birthday. September, January or April.

30 hours Funding for 3 and 4 year olds

You must apply here www.childcarechoices.gov.uk
If you have applied and are eligible for 30 hours funding you will receive a code from the government. Please then send us a message to the office via Famly including the code and your national insurance number so that we can claim the hours. You will need to validate this code 3 times per year You do not need to re-apply for 2 year old or any other funding.

When first applying for the 30 hours you must provide us the code by these dates:

20th August

15th December

20th March

We cannot accept codes for the following terms after these dates.

Are funded hours term time only?

Yes, Little Explorers offers funded hours during term time only. Please view our term calendar here https://www.littleexplorershythe.com/documents-and-policies

During non-funded times you can book and pay for extra hours by requesting these through a Famly message to the office

Your child will not automatically be booked in for their funded hours during non-funded times (e.g. half term holidays), only for their paid hours.

Can you pay for additional hours?

You can pay for other additional hours around your entitlement. Invoices are sent out around the 14^{th} of each month and need to be paid by 28^{th} . You are paying in advance for the following month

You will still be charged for these hours during non-funded times.

How can you use these hours at Little Explorers?

Choose between 3 or 5 hour blocks

3 hour blocks 9am-12pm, 12pm-3pm or 3pm-6pm

5 hour blocks 8am-1pm or 1pm-6pm

15 hours children can choose either 5 x 3 hour blocks or 3 x 5 hour blocks.

30 hours children can choose either 10 x 3 hours blocks or 6 x 5 hour blocks

Sessions can be slotted together to form longer days. Any hours outside of these times will be paid for.

Do I have anything extra to pay?

We offer all-inclusive childcare. You drop your child off and we provide everything they need. We ask parents of funded children to contribute towards this care package at a cost of £1 per hour. Please read our handbook for details.
